OSAPA LONDON YOUTH ORGANIZATION (OLYO)



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PREAMBLE



Osapa London Youth Organization, OLYO, is a voluntary nongovernmental community based organization, with Comrade Rilwan Muritala Eletu-Odibo as the convener, who shall have absolute authority for the progress and development of the organization.

We the members of OLYO, having firmly and solemnly resolved to form one indivisible and indissoluble organization, dedicated to the promotion of unity and harmony among ourselves, and to the up-liftment of our living conditions, and for the purpose of consolidating the unity and development of our people;

Determined to achieve, in cooperation with one another in the development of the members of OLYO and to realize our objectives through the medium of association herein constituted;

Do hereby make, enact and give to ourselves the following constitution:-

ARTICLE I: SUPREMACY, NAME AND THE GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1:

- 1. This constitution shall be supreme and its provisions shall have binding force on all members.
- 2. All activities, engagement, resolutions, decisions or undertakings carried on or taken in the name of OLYO shall be in accordance with the provisions of this constitution.
- 3. Any other law, regulations, resolutions or rules that may be made by this Organization shall be null and void to the extent of the inconsistency.
- **4.** The Organization established by this constitution shall be known, addressed and called OSAPA LONDON YOUTH ORGANIZATION, hereinafter referred to as "OLYO".
- 5. The registered Headquarter office shall be at Osapa London, Eti-Osa L.G.A., Lagos State, Nigeria.

ARTICLE II: MOTTO, LOGO/EMBLEM AND SLOGAN SECTION 2:

- 1. The motto of Osapa London Youth Organization (OLYO) shall be "Service to Humanity-Sustainable Development".
- 2. The Logo/Emblem of OLYO shall represent "DEVELOPMENT".
- 3. The slogan shall be known as "OUR FUTURE, IN OUR HANDS".

ARTICLE III: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

SECTION 3



- 1. The aims and Objectives of OLYO shall be:
- (a) To promote and foster unity among the entire people of Osapa London;
- (b) To promote and enhance the human and material resources for socioeconomic, political and educational advancement of our people;
- (c) To promote and preserve the culture, norms and values of the people of Osapa London;
- (d) Liaise and cooperate with the government, other organizations and associations with similar objectives;
- (e) To encourage, organize and execute self-help projects;
- **(f)** Organize literacy class for adults, computer training programme, vocational programme, medical outreach, orphanagen and prisoners support, and summer lesson programme;
- (g) Organize environmental sanitation program, tree planting, and encourage public enlightenment activities such as symposiums, debates, seminars, cultural shows, sports etc.
- (h) Undertake such revenue generating activities that would enhance the realization of OLYO's objectives;
- (i) Encourage self-reliance through self-employment;
- (j) Encourage and inculcate moral values among its members, by nurturing future leaders who will drive positive change in society;
- (k) Raise funds from membership dues, grants, governments, donor agencies, NGOs, cooperatives, multinational organizations and individuals in furtherance with OLYO's objectives.

ARTICLE IV: VISION AND MISSION

- 1. The vision and mission of OLYO shall be:-
- (a) To establish a community where "everyone" irrespective of religions, ethnicities, political and socio-economic background can thrive;
- (b) To create a safer and caring environment that encourages healthy, fulfilling and dignified lifestyle, and to enable the youth achieve their full potentials;
- (c) To intensify engagements through our drives (utilize mechanisms).



ARTICLE V: AFFILIATION



SECTION 5

- 1. OLYO shall be affiliated with United Nations Youth (UN Youth), Rotaract (by Rotary International), European Youth Forum (YFJ), National Youth Council of Nigeria (NYCN), Commonwealth Youth Council (CYC), Nigeria Youth Parliament, ECOWAS Youth Parliament, Young African Leaders Initiative (YALI), AIESEC, Nigeria Youth Organization (Lagos Chapter), SustyVibes, Seamoriow Sports, Lagos Community Youth Development Initiative (LCYDI), Youth Assembly of Nigeria, Eti-Osa Indigenous Students' Association, Eti-Osa Youth Organization and other multilateral associations, organizations with similar aims and objectives.
- 2. OLYO shall not be affiliated to any political party or religious organization, except for the promotion of its objectives.

ARTICLE VI: MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATION AND ADMISSION

SECTION 6

- 1. Membership shall be open to all residents and working class of Osapa London between the age of 17 to 50, irrespective of religion, political affiliation, ethnicity and socio-economic status.
- 2. A member is accepted after filling Membership Registration Form, via www.osapalondonyouthorganization.com.
- 3. Members shall be registered with the sum of N20,000, paid into OLYO Zenith Bank account (1310684315), before submission of the form.
- **4.** An ID CARD, hardcopy constitution, OLYO shirt and cap, shall be issued to all members after payment.

ARTICLE VII: RIGHT OF MEMBERS

- 1. Every member shall have the right to partake in any discussion and provide his reasonable opinion in all activities of OLYO.
- 2. All members shall enjoy equal privileges and opportunities accrued to the entire members of OLYO.
- 3. Every member shall have the right to be recognized as distinguished and properly addressed at the meeting in accordance with the constitution.
- 4. Members shall be eligible to run for executive or administrative positions within the organization.
- 5. Members shall have the right to vote on important decisions, and leadership elections.

ARTICLE VIII: MEMBERS DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS



SECTION 8

- **1.** Members who are given probation shall be on suspension for a period to be determined by the Executive not exceeding twomonths, depending on the gravity of the offense committed.
- 2. Member who discusses other member's businesses, rumors or indulges in character assassination with a negatives intention that may results in pain, anguish and stress, such member shall be liable upon conviction, fine not exceeding N5,000 or excommunicated.
- 3. Constant refusal by a member to abide by the constitution and the rules, or engages in any act that will bring OLYO into disrepute, shall be subject to dismissal and collection of any property of OLYO in his/her position.

ARTICLE IX: SUPREME COUNCIL

- 1. There shall be for OLYO a Supreme Council, who shall:-
- (a) Be the overall decision-making body of OLYO;
- (b) Decide on matters that are appropriate, consider and approve reports submitted by the Executive;
- (c) Be made-up with at least above two people;
- (d) Meet at least once in every months;
- (e) Possesses the right to summon the Executives when there is disarray;
- **(f)** Together with the Executive acquire any moveable and immovable property for OLYO;
- **(g)** Manage any foundation funds, shares or other securities of OLYO with the Executive;
- **(h)** Perform such other functions as statutorily required and as may from time to time be required by the Executive;
- (i) Take over the conduct of the affairs of OLYO whenever the house is in disarray to the extent that it can no longer meet and take decisions in the interest of OLYO, for the purpose of restoring normalcy within 3 months.
- (j) The convener of OLYO, Comrade Rilwan Muritala Eletu-Odibo shall be a permanent member.

ARTICLE X: THE EXECUTIVE




- 1. The executive shall:-
- (a) Be the managerial and working organ of OLYO and shall initiate and execute programmes and projects with regard to the aims and objectives and within the framework, guidelines and policies laid down by the general meeting;
- **(b)** Be individually and collectively responsible for their action and shall be subject in all respects to the general meeting;
- (c) Appoint members of the standing committees in direction of the President and such other ad-hoc committees as will aid in the realization of the objectives of OLYO;
- (d) Recommend to the Supreme Council any measures that will lead to the realization of the aims and objectives of OLYO;
- (e) Meet at least once a month;
- (f) Take decisions on ways of ensuring the proper running and coordination of OLYO;
- (g) From time to time fix any such levy to be paid by members of OLYO;
- (h) Approve the raising of funds from any reputable organization;
- (i) Maintain an up-to-date accurate records of OLYO's accounts and all other financial transactions;
- (j) Observe all proper accounting procedures, audit and maintain probity at least once a year;
- **(k)** Submit yearly budgetary proposal by the Executive officers and approved by the President;
- (l) Clearly spelt out supported documents properly signed by the appropriate officers;
- (m) Subject the expenditure to be in line with the aims and objectives of OLYO and budgetary estimates;
- (n) In accordance of the constitution, where any expenditure is to be made outside the approved estimate, a supplementary budget shall be presented and approved by the President.
- 2. The Executive shall comprise of the following officers:-



- (a) President
- (b) Vice President
- (c) General Secretary
- (d) Assistant General Secretary
- (e) Treasurer
- (f) Financial Secretary
- (g) Social Welfare
- (h) Assistant Social Welfare
- (i) Auditor General
- (j) Director Media and Publicity
- (k) Publisher
- (l) Photographer
- (m) Youth Leader
- (n) Assitant Youth Leader
- (o) Woman Leader
- (p) Provost I
- (q) Provost II
- (r) Ex-Officio I
- 3. PRESIDENT: There shall be for OLYO a President, who shall:-
- (a) Be the Head of the Executive body of OLYO;
- **(b)** Be the spokesperson of OLYO to the general public, or appoint any official for the task;
- (c) Preside over meetings of the Executive, appoint any member as a delegate to oversee other official activities, and any meetings that may be consider as imperative to OLYO;
- (d) Be responsible for OLYO's relationship with its affiliated bodies as stated in Article 3, Section 3, Paragraph 1(d);



- (e) Direct and supervise all other officers in the performance of their duties;
- **(f)** Call for the Supreme Council meeting, in consultation with the Executive members;
- (g) In conjunction with the General Secretary summons and sign all Executive meeting, general meetings and any other meetings;
- (h) Perform any function(s) that may appear reasonable in the execution of his/her duties;
- (i) Be a category A signatory to OLYO's Bank Acount;
- (j) Posses the veto to choose between category B or category C signatory on an agreement or document of any kind;
- (k) Be in possession of OLYO Automobile Teller Machine (ATM) card;
- (I) Only a paternal indigenous person of Osapa London shall have the right and prerogative to occupy the position of the President.
- **4. VICE PRESIDENT**: There shall be for OLYO a Vice President, who shall:-
- (a) Serve as a key Presidential adviser, governing partner and representative of the President in his/her absence;
- **(b)** Coordinate and supervise the activities as may be assigned by the President;
- (c) Perform any function(s) that may appear reasonable in the execution of his/her duties and function.
- **5. GENERAL SECRETARY**: There shall be for OLYO a General Secretary, who shall:-
- (a) Be the chief scribe and shall undertake correspondences for and on behalf of OLYO;
- (b) Keep and maintain effective records of all members;
- (c) Summon the meetings of the Executive, General, and any other meeting as directed by the President or otherwise in accordance with the provision of the constitution;
- (d) Take and keep minutes of meetings;
- (e) Compile with the assistance of other Executive members, an annual report of OLYO's activities;





- (g) File all original copies of legal documents, the constitution and bylaws, reports, newsletters and other publications, approved minutes of the meeting, membership roster, correspondences, conference proceedings, and other records;
- (h) Be accountable for any missing records under his/her supervision;
- **6. ASSISTANT GENERAL Secretary**: There shall be for OLYO an Assistant Secretary General, who shall:-
- (a) Perform such duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the General Secretary and President.
- **(b)** Assist or deputized as the General Secretary whenever such need arises.
 - 7. TREASURER: There shall be for OLYO a Treasurer, who shall:-
- (a) Receive all monies handed over to him/her and shall obtain a receipt for such payments, subject to the direction of the President;
- (b) Collect and pay into OLYO's account all monies collected within 48 hours of such receipts, unless on weekends and public holidays, in which the money should be paid on the next working day;
- (c) Surrender all monetary documents, bank notes, pass books, cheques etc to the Financial Secretary, under the direction of the President and assist the Executive when the need arises even if he/she is out of office;
- (d) Be a category B signatory to OLYO's account.
- 8. FINANCIAL SECRETARY: There shall be for OLYO a Financial Secretary, who shall:-
- (a) Keep record of all payments of income and expenditure, under the direction of the President;
- **(b)** Prepare and present annual financial report to the Executive meeting, and General meeting, under the direction of the President.
- (c) Shall maintain custody of OLYO's property, financial books, records, and checks, under the direction of the President.



- **10. SOCIAL WELFARE**: There shall be for OLYO a Social Welfare, who shall:-
- (a) Handle budget planning, as well as the design, maintenance, management and statistics events;
- (b) Teach and train new members on their rights, duties and privileges;
- (c) Engage a campaign on issues affecting members;
- (d) Bring to the notice of the Executive, the grievances of members, with a view to secure expeditious redress;
- (e) Be in charge and be responsible for all social activities;
- **(f)** To advise on questions relating to provisions of welfare facilities, such as housing facilities, food items, social and recreational facilities, sanitation, individual personal problems and education of children.
- **11. ASSISTANT SOCIAL WELFARE**: There shall be for OLYO an Assistant Social Welfare, who shall:-
- (a) Assist the Social Welfare and assume his/her duties and responsibilities at all times.
- **12. AUDITOR GENERAL**: There shall be for OLYO an Auditor General, who shall:-
- (a) Perform procedural audits or as required by the President when necessary;
- (b) Perform comprehensive annual audits no later than 30 days after the end of each financial fiscal year;
- (c) Be category C signatory to OLYO's account.
- **13. MEDIA AND PUBLICITY:** There shall be for OLYO Media and Publicity who shall consist of:-
- (a)i. Director, Media and Publicity,
 - (ii) Publisher and
 - (iii) Photographer;
 - **(b)** Be responsible for the coordination of all researches and public information activities;
 - (c) Be the custodian of OLYO's website and social media accounts, under the direction of the President.



- (d) Establish and maintain cordial relationship between OLYO and all social media platforms and ensure that Press Releases are given adequate publicity on the directive of the President;
- 14. YOUTH LEADER: There shall be for OLYO, Youth Leader who shall:-
- (a) Be responsible for mobilisation of the Youth for the attainment of OLYO objectives;
- (b) Advise on strategies for mobilization of the Youth;
- (c) Initiate and implement strategic programmes that will endear OLYO consultation with other stakeholders;
- (d) Perform such functions as may be assigned to him/her from time to time by the President.
- **15. ASSISTANT YOUTH LEADER:** There shall be for OLYO an Assistant Youth Leader, who shall:-
- (a) Perform such duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the Youth Leader or the President.
- 16. WOMAN LEADER: There shall be for OLYO, Woman Leader who shall:-
- (a) Advise on strategies for mobilization for women;
- **(b)** Initiate and implement strategic programmes that will endear OLYO consultation with other stakeholders;
- (c) Perform such functions as may be assigned to her from time to time by the President.
- 17. PROVOST I: There shall be for OLYO, Provost I who shall:-

Be responsible for the enforcement of discipline and the maintenance of law and order during the activities of OLYO;

Be responsible for collecting fines imposed by OLYO on the member.

18. PROVOST II: There shall be for OLYO, Provost II, who shall:-

Assist the Provost 1 in the above mentioned responsibilities.

18. EX-OFFICIO I: There shall be for OLYO, Ex-Officio who shall:-

Perform any function(s) as may be directed by the President and shall also serve as any advisory body.

ARTICLE XI: LOSS OF EXECUTIVE OFFICE

- (a) An executive member shall be deemed to have lost his/her membership, if:
- (b) Becomes insane;
- (c) Embezzles OLYO's fund or conversion of OLYO's property;
- (d) Convicted of criminal offence by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- (e) By death.
- (f) In arrears of his/her dues and levies for up to 3 Months.
- (g) Does not attend at least two-third of the general assembly meetings or misses 3 consecutive meetings without giving cogent reason to the President; and frequently not participating in the Executive meetings.
- (h) Upon removal by 2/3 majority vote of the general members present in a meeting convened for that purpose, in which his/her character or behavior is inimical to the affairs of OLYO, provided that in the case of expulsion, the Executive officer must have been found guilty.
- (i) Any Executive officers has the right to resign and withdraw his/her membership anytime for any or no reason. The reason for such resignation shall be investigated.
- (j) In case of the President's deficiencies, the Supreme Council shall be the determinant of the verdict.
- (k) Public misconduct (including smoking in public is prohibited (2)): Engaging in behavior, such as public smoking or drug use, that contradicts the organization's values.
- (l) Defamation and tarnishing the image of fellow Executives: Spreading false information or making baseless accusations against colleagues.
- (m) Engaging in character assassination that damages the leadership team's reputation.
- (n) Breach of confidentiality: Leaking sensitive organization information to unauthorized persons.



- (o) Using confidential data for personal advantage.
- (p) Dereliction of duty: Consistent failure to fulfill assigned responsibilities.
- Conflict of Interest: Engaging in entitlement activities that compromise loyalty to the organization; multipractices that posses threat to OLYO.
- (r) Holding undisclosed personal or financial stakes in rival organizations.

ARTICLE XII: TENURE OF OFFICE

SECTION 12

- 1. Members of the executive shall hold office for a period of 4 years and may be re-appointed to another subsequent term.
- 2. Such officers may be eligible for election to another position other than the one he/she had occupied.
- Subject to the provision of this constitution, an Executive shall hold office until when his/her successor in office takes the oath of that office.
- The date when his/her resignation from office takes effect; he/she otherwise ceases to hold office in accordance with the provisions of the constitution.

ARTICLE XIII: STANDING COMMITTEES

SECTION 13

- 1. There shall be three standing committees for OLYO, namely:
- (a) Cultural and Creativity Committee
- (b) Education and Documentation Committee
- (c) Research and Development Committee

2. COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEES:

- (a) The chairman and members of the committees shall be appointed by the President, and will stand dissolve after expiration of their duty;
- **(b)** The standing committees shall report and be answerable to the President.



- (c) The committees shall meet as often as required but not less than once in every month.
- **3. THE DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEES:** The Cultural and Creativity Committee shall:-
- (a) Conduct research into the culture of Osapa London;
- **(b)** Collect for preservation and display of all cultural and historical files;
- (c) Coordinate the youths of Osapa London annual cultural festival;
- (d) Organize social and cultural functions that will promote unity and progress in Osapa London, and also preserve its cultural heritage;
- (e) Produce documentaries on the socio-economic activities of the cultures and traditions of Osapa London;
- (f) Submit report to the President.
- **4. EDUCATION AND DOCUMENTATION COMMITTEE**: Education and Documentation Committee shall:-
- (a) Identify opportunities for self-employment and educational advancement for the teaming youths;
- **(b)** Collect and analyze any available data on the historical evolution of Osapa London and its people;
- (c) Submit report to the President.
- **5. DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**: Research and Development Committee shall:-
- (a) Identify investment opportunities;
- **(b)** Mobilize and invite potential investors for exploration of the opportunities on the land;
- (c) Undertake feasibility studies and recommend any viable projects worth undertaking by OLYO;
- (d) Submit report to the President.
- 6. DISSOLUTION OF COMMITTEES
- (a) The tenure of office of an ad-hoc committee shall lapse on completion of its terms of reference.



- **(b)** Any committee may be recommended for dissolution by the President or any member for non-performance.
- (c) A committee member shall be recommended for replacement by the President after gaining the wills of the majority, if its conduct in the opinion of the members is detrimental to the progress of the committee.

ARTICLE XIV: SECRETARIAT

SECTION 14

- 1. There shall be a secretariat of OLYO to be situated at Osapa London.
- (a) The staff of the Secretariat shall be headed by an Administrative Secretary, appointed by the Convener.
- (b) The staff(s) of the Secretariat shall be appointed by the Convener.

ARTICLE XV: GRANDPATRON, PATRONS & BOARD OF TRUSTEES

SECTION 15

- 1. There shall be a Grand Patron and Patrons of OLYO to be appointed by the Executives and shall be men and women of unquestionable character.
- 2. The Grand Patron shall be the King/Chief and Head of Osapa London.
- 3. The Board of Trustees shall be appointed by the convener, while the convener shall serve as permanent chairman.

ARTICLE XVI: FINANCES

- 1. The sources of revenue for OLYO shall include, viz:
- (a) Registration fees, membership dues, levies, donations, launching of appeal funds, fund raising activities, subventions for specific projects from the Local, State and Federal Government, investments and proceeds from other commercial ventures.
- 2. The Convener shall maintain and control current and savings accounts into which all funds belonging to OLYO shall be paid.
- 3. There shall be three signatories to OLYO's account namely: The President, the Treasurer and the Auditor General.



- **3.** The President shall choose any between the two signatories to sign for withdrawal.
- **4.** In the advent of absence of the Treasurer and Auditor General, the President shall make use of the Automobile Teller Machine (ATM) card at when necessary.

ARTICLE XVII: ELECTIONS

- 1. Elections into offices of the Executives shall be held every 4 years.
- 2. Only accredited or registered members of OLYO, as spelt out in this constitution shall be admitted and allowed to vote and be voted for.
- 3. There shall be ad-hoc electoral officers at the time of the election, who shall;
- (a) Comprise the minimum of two and the maximum of five, one of whom shall preside as the Chairman of the electoral committee and shall be appointed by the Convener;
- (b) Can vote during the said election;
- (c) Control, conduct and lay down rules of procedure necessary for the conduct of the election within a specific period of time.
- **4.** All elective officers of OLYO shall cease to function at the expiration of their tenure, and their offices shall be deemed vacant; except if reelected.
- 5. The nominated candidates for a post may each stand up in the hall to give a brief introduction through manifesto presentation.
- **6.** All elections shall be by open ballot, using ballot, computer, any electronic device or such ordinary papers duly stamped by the electoral committee or any procedure that may be reasonably justifiable in the conduct of the election.
- (a) Where only one candidate has been nominated, the candidate so nominated shall be deemed unopposed and declared duly elected.
- (b) Where there is no candidate for any post, the Convener in consultation with other stakeholders shall have the powers to appoint any member to the post, and shall be deemed to have been duly elected.


- (c) In the event of a tie, there shall be a second ballot for the candidate involved.
- 7. Where an office become vacant by reason of death, resignation, removal or any other reasonable cause, the President shall appoint an officer to occupy the vacant office through majority nomination.
- 8. An Executive officer wishing to resign must give one-month notice in writing and shall have his/her resignation accepted by the Executive, the officer must give an account of his/her stewardship and handover all properties belonging to OLYO in his/her custody.

ARTICLE XVIII: MEETINGS

- 1. There shall be a meeting for OLYO that shall be convene and hold in accordance with the provisions of this constitution.
- 2. In the event of failure by the President to call for the general meetings, then in respect of Executive meetings, at least five of the members of the Executive may jointly in writing call for the meeting;
- 3. For the purpose of the Executive meeting, two-third of the officers shall form a quorum.
- **4.** For the general meeting, a simple majority of the registered members shall form a quorum.
- 5. Decisions at all meetings shall be by simple majority except otherwise provided for by this constitution.
- 6. There shall be two main types of meetings for OLYO, viz:-
- (a) MONTHLY GENERAL MEETING: Shall be held on the third Sunday of every Months. Meeting starts at exactly 4:00pm and ends at 6:00pm and motion to extend the meeting beyond 6:00pm may be passed and approved by the house.
- **(b)** EXTRAORDINARY MEETING: The General Secretary in consultation with the President shall call for an Extra-Ordinary General Meeting for any of the following reasons.
- (i) Urgent matter(s) affecting the affairs of OLYO or its members, that required the attention of the general membership, such that has to be resolved before the next gener al meeting.
- (c) If for any reason no general meeting was held as scheduled, an extraordinary meeting should be summoned

- (i) The President shall call the meeting to order;
- (ii) The President shall preside over the meeting;





- **8.** A member shall raise his hand or seek the permission of the President to be recognized to speak or address the house.
- **9.** A member who is unable to stay for the duration of the meeting shall notify the President prior to the commencement of the meeting.
- 10. No member shall take part in the consumption of alcohol or smoking or engages in any act of similar nature, prior to the commencement of the meeting and during the meeting.
- 11. All dues shall be collected at the beginning of the meeting and all fines and levies shall be collected at the end of the meeting, or any time that may appear reasonable by the members of the Executive.
- 12. All fines will be levied by the President. In the absence of the President, the Vice President or a designated member will be conferred with the authority to do so.

ARTICLE XIX: DISCIPLINE

- SERVICE TO HUMANITY SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT
- 1. OLYO shall maintain and promote a high standard of discipline in all its affairs, and in particular, at all meetings and within the Executive members.
- 2. Accordingly, the following shall constitute acts of indiscipline:
- (a) Misbehavior during meetings;
- (b) Use of abusive or vulgar language on any member during meetings;
- (c) Engaging in activities detrimental to the existence, progress and integrity of OLYO;
- **(b)** Financial misconduct;
- (e) Non-attendance of Executive meetings, and General Meetings by any officer for three consecutive times without putting it in a writing format or give reasonable explanation to the President;





- (f) Dereliction of duty;
- (g) Lack of respect for constituted authority;
- **(h)** Any other behavior detrimental to the aims and objectives, or appear to injures the prestige of OLYO.
- **3.** All cases of indiscipline involving a member of the Executive officers shall be enquired into and determined by an ad-hoc disciplinary committee of three members appointed by the Executive and its decision shall be approve by the President.
- **4.** In all other cases of indiscipline involving members of OLYO, the Executive shall, for that purpose, constitute a disciplinary committee to determine the issue, under the direction of the President.
- 5. In the event where the President is being alleged for any misconduct, the Executive officers shall summon the Supreme Council and necessary action shall be taken to such effect, subject to the decision of the Supreme Council.

ARTICLE XX: CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

- 1. A member loses his membership in the following ways:
- (a) By Death
- (b) By resignation SERVICE TO HUMANITY SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT
- (c) On expulsion
- (d) A deceased member, upon being accorded his final right, ceases to be a member.
- (e) A member who voluntarily notifies OLYO in writing of his/her intention to resign his/her membership shall upon being cleared of his/her financial obligation cease to be a member.
- (f) The President shall have powers to suspend or expel a member whose character or behavior is inimical to the affairs of OLYO, provided that in the case of expulsion, the member must have been found guilty of misconduct.
- (g) Nonpayment of monthly dues/levies upto three consecutive months and owing of other debts when they become due for payment.



(h) A person convicted of any criminal offence by a court of competent jurisdiction.

ARTICLE XXI: AMENDMENTS

SECTION 21

- 1. This constitution or any part thereof may be amended, rescinded, altered or addition as made thereof, by a resolution carried at by a majority of two-third of those present at the general meeting of OLYO..
- 2. Proposals regarding amendments of the constitution must be sent to the Executive at least two weeks before the Monthly General Meeting of OLYO for inclusion in the agenda and must be communicated in writing.
- **3.** The Convener shall establish a committee and approve the commencement of the amendment.

ARTICLE XXII: INTERPRETATION

SECTION 22

In this part of the Constitution, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- 1. "Ad-hock Committee" A committee formed by the Executive to carry out a specific purpose, or formed for the purpose of helping the Executive officers in carrying out a project.
- 2. OLYO is the acronym of Osapa London Youth Organization.
- **3.** "Patrons" are Highly respected personalities who gives moral and financial support to the development of OLYO.
- **4.** "Quorum" The minimum number of members required at a meeting for the purpose of voting decision to be valid, or if the quorum is not reached, the vote and the decision cannot be taking at the meeting.
- **5.** "Resolution" The act of affirming to do, or not to do something.
- 6. "Simple Resolution" The process or act of affirming an idea by a majority decision in the meeting.
- 7. "Supreme Council" Group of respected persons who are recognized as the highest decision making body in OLYO.



- **9.** "Tenor" A particular period of time wherein the Executive members may occupy offices which shall be four years and may be extended to another four years upon an election.
- **8.** This Constitution shall be sited as e.g. "ARTICLE 3; SECTION 3; PARAGRAPH 1(a), Page 2.

ARTICLE XXIII: DEDICATION

SECTION 23

1. Statement of Dedication

This Constitution is hereby dedicated to the founding father of Osapa London, High Chief Gbadamosi Bamidele Eletu-Odibo, and the indissoluble and indefatigable members of Osapa London Youth Organization (OLYO) — those who have tirelessly contributed their resources, time, effort, and unwavering commitment to the unity, development, and progress of our organization and community.

It is dedicated to the visionary leaders, our Patrons and Grandpatron, past and present, who have laid the foundation for the growth of Osapa London, as well as to the future generations who will uphold and advance its values.

This document stands as a testament to our shared purpose, our unwavering resilience, and our collective determination to foster a society where unity, service, and sustainable development remain at the core of our mission.

Through this Constitution, we reaffirm our commitment to building a thriving community, upholding justice and integrity, and ensuring that OLYO remains a beacon of hope, empowerment, and progress for all.
